

Record of Administered Asthma Medication

- Use this sheet to record each time a student needs to use his/her blue inhaler for relief of asthma symptoms. The most commonly prescribed "reliever" inhaler is called Salbutamol (generic name) or Ventolin (brand name).
- If the child requires his/her blue "reliever" inhaler more than twice in a typical school week, it is an indication that his/her asthma is not under control. It is important to inform the parent when this happens as the child may require an adjustment to his/her "preventer" medications that are taken at home.
